2016 SCQP – The “HUNLEY CHALLENGE” Award

This special award was created for the 2016 SCQP to commemorate the mission of the *H.L. Hunley* submarine against the federal blockade ship *USS Housatonic* off the coast of Charleston, SC on February 17, 1864. The H.L. Hunley was the first submarine to sink an enemy ship.

Objective: Awarded to stations spelling “HUNLEY” during the 2016 South Carolina QSO Party by contacting at least **ONE** amateur radio operator located in counties which begin with these letters.

Qualifying counties:

H – Hampton Horry

U – Union

N – Newberry

L – Lancaster Laurens Lee Lexington

E – Edgefield

Y – York

Those who complete this challenge will receive a commemorative certificate via email.

Wildcard Station – N4HLH

N4HLH will be a “Wildcard” station. Valid contacts with N4HLH may be used as a “wildcard” contacts for **TWO** of the required letter counties. You may only work this station **ONCE** per MODE per BAND.

Example: You make valid contacts with stations located in Horry, Union, Newberry and Lancaster counties, but you didn’t work any stations in Edgefield and York counties. You made two valid contacts with N4HLH. You can use the two valid contacts you made with N4HLH for your “E” and “Y” counties to qualify for the special award.

How to submit your “HUNLEY CHALLENGE” Award Application

1. Go to <http://scqso.com>
2. Click on “Hunley Challenge Award” main menu item
3. Click on “HUNLEY CHALLENGE Award Application” link
4. Complete the application form AND upload your SCQP Cabrillo log
5. Click “Submit Application” button. All done

Stations who qualify for this award will be listed on www.scqso.com. Submissions for this award must be submitted via our website within 30 days of the SCQP. There is no charge for this award.
